We successfully hosted our annual events including Race for YMCA, Niles-Buchanan YMCA Thanksgiving Day Run, Greatest Chefs of Michiana, Hope Grows, and LIVESTRONG® at the YMCA Golf Classic to provide funding support for youth and family memberships, cancer survivors and youth programs.

We worked with community partners to promote health and wellness with programs including Healthy Corner Store Initiative, Optimist Soccer, Benton Harbor Summer Impact, Healthy Kids Days, Kitchen Aid Senior PGA Kids Zone, and Corporate Wellness.

Our goals for 2023 are to continue to be a committed, engaged, and determined collaborative partner; to build community connectedness and cohesion; provide opportunity; and strengthen health and wellness for all.

## 2021-2024 Strategic Plan Accomplishments in 2022

### YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

We provided our youth and teens with programs that strengthen social responsibility and character values. We supported before and afterschool care, preschool, summer camps, holiday camps, sport leagues, swim teams/lessons, kids night out, nutrition and physical education.

### HEALTHY LIVING

We aligned with local community needs to provide support for a healthier community through programs that address cancer survivors, food insecurity, CPR/First Aid, nutrition and physical education. We stay committed to building a healthy environment with our local partners.

### OPERATIONAL & FINANCIAL

Each year we establish a fund development plan encompassing annual, capital, and fundraising event goals to support the Y's programs, financial scholarships, and capital needs. In 2022, contribution and fundraising revenue represented almost 24% of the Y's total revenue.

## Body by Y

Judy Bradford's first memory of the YMCA is dropping her brother off at the Hamilton, Ohio, YMCA for swim lessons circa 1960. "Back then, nude swimming for boys in all-male classes was accepted, and sometimes mandated, because, for one reason, suits were made of natural fibers which could gum up a filtration system," she said.

Fast-forward to 1984, and Judy is taking her 5-month-old son to "Learn to Swim" classes at the YMCA in South Bend.

"He loved the water and, as they say, took to it like a fish. The same with my daughter who was born in 1986. They both wore swimsuits," she said.

The Y became the place where they learned how to play basketball and dance.

"The lessons they learned about being part of a team, or how to behave in a class, are priceless and would be carried into their formal schooling and beyond. The programs were affordable for a young family, and the times for practices and classes were doable for two parents with full-time jobs," she said.

And now, enjoying retirement, she has once again become a "Y Rat," going to classes throughout the week like Body Pump, Body Balance (Yoga), Zumba and Dance Fit.

"I know my instructors and interact with them on a personal level. I work out with people I know, and stay updated on what's happening in their lives. This rat loves to socialize," she said.

One of Judy's mottos is "Body by Y" - recognizing that real people have imperfect bodies and can still value strength and endurance no matter what they look like.

One of the other things she loves about YMCA O'Brien Center is that it's also a polling location.

"I love the idea of voting before or after a class. No extra trip. Just slip it in between some crunches and some stretches. Get it done, make it happen. And all with our clothes on," she said.




