2021-2024 Strategic Plan Accomplishments in 2024

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

We provided youth and teens with programs that strengthen social responsibility and character values. We supported before and afterschool care, preschool, summer camps, holiday camps, sports leagues, swim teams/lessons, kids night out, nutrition and physical education.

HEALTHY LIVING

We aligned with local community needs to provide support for a healthier community through programs that address cancer survivors, food insecurity, CPR/First Aid, nutrition and physical education. We stay committed to building a healthy environment with our local partners.

OPERATIONAL & FINANCIAL

Each year we establish a fund development plan encompassing annual, capital, and fundraising event goals to support the Y's programs, financial scholarships, and capital needs. In 2024, contribution and fundraising revenue represented almost 20% of the Y's total revenue.

DIVING INTO HEALTH AT THE Y

For Christine Sturgill and her friend Anne Held, a simple kickboarding routine turned into a life-changing journey. After Christine faced complications from a hysterectomy, the two friends began swimming across a local lake, helping Christine regain her strength and overcome severe shortness of breath. But as the weather cooled, they needed a new place to continue their routine—leading them to the Downtown South Bend YMCA.

“We FELL IN LOVE with the YMCA DOWNTOWN!!!” Christine shared. “We immediately became part of a community that willingly opened their arms and accepted us.”

Since joining, they’ve lost a combined 131 pounds and gained something even more valuable—a welcoming, supportive community. Whether it’s sharing lanes in the pool or unwinding in the hot tub after a workout, Christine and Anne have found their hidden gem in the heart of downtown.

WE GROW PEOPLE AT THE Y

For nearly 14 years, I've had the privilege of being a part of the Y community, and it's been a journey that has shaped my life in so many meaningful ways. My story began at River School in Sodus #5, where I first came to the YMCA as part of the Healthy U program. I was fortunate to be guided by the wonderful Monica Norton (currently the Senior Healthy Living Director) during that time. Additionally, I had the opportunity to learn swimming under the instruction of the incredible Mary Lamar and LeeAnn Schneider—experiences that set the foundation for many of my future accomplishments.

This partnership wouldn't have been possible without the dedication of the YMCA staff and the vision of River School's principal at the time, Andy Velez, who also worked at the Y and helped make this collaboration happen.

A year later, my mother, Rachel Reynolds, began working at the YMCA in housekeeping, further strengthening our family's connection to the Y. She gradually climbed her way up as have I and is now the Housekeeping Manager. She would bring me and my sisters to swim, play in the gym, and enjoy the KidZone—programs that the Y offered at the time. We also participated in community events like Race for Y, Healthy Kids Day, Trunk or Treat, and countless other opportunities to engage and give back.

Fast forward nine years, I started working part-time at the Y's front desk. Over the years, I've been fortunate to grow within the organization, eventually becoming the Member Services Manager (Front Desk Manager). I owe so much to the Y, to the amazing staff—Monica, Mary, LeeAnn, Andy, Rachel, and so many others—for their unwavering support in helping me achieve my personal and professional goals. I'm still on this journey, and I'm excited for the many more milestones ahead.

2024 YMCA CAMP EBERHART

For 116 years, YMCA Camp Eberhart has been a place where kids build confidence, develop lifelong skills, and form lasting friendships. In 2024, nearly 3,000 summer campers experienced the adventure of camp, learning new skills, making friends, and strengthening core values like caring, honesty, and respect.

Beyond summer camp, Camp Eberhart offers outdoor education programming in the spring, fall, and winter—serving nearly 4,000 students from 89 schools and youth organizations in 2024. Family camps provide another opportunity for connection, giving families a chance to spend quality time together in nature over holiday weekends.



INVESTING IN THE FUTURE

- \$1 million+ invested in facility improvements at YMCA Camp Eberhart, including:
 - \$200,000 in ADA upgrades to improve accessibility for all campers
 - \$566,000 to renovate Dave’s House
 - \$75,000 to complete the renovation of Coop’s Coop
 - \$63,500 to install a generator in Klinger Hall to ensure a reliable power source in Camp’s remote location, providing a safe space during power outages
 - \$56,650 to install upgraded fencing around the horse fields to improve safety for both horses and local wildlife
- 1,800+ volunteer hours contributed by Pete, “Camp’s Volunteer Angel,” toward Coop’s Coop renovation

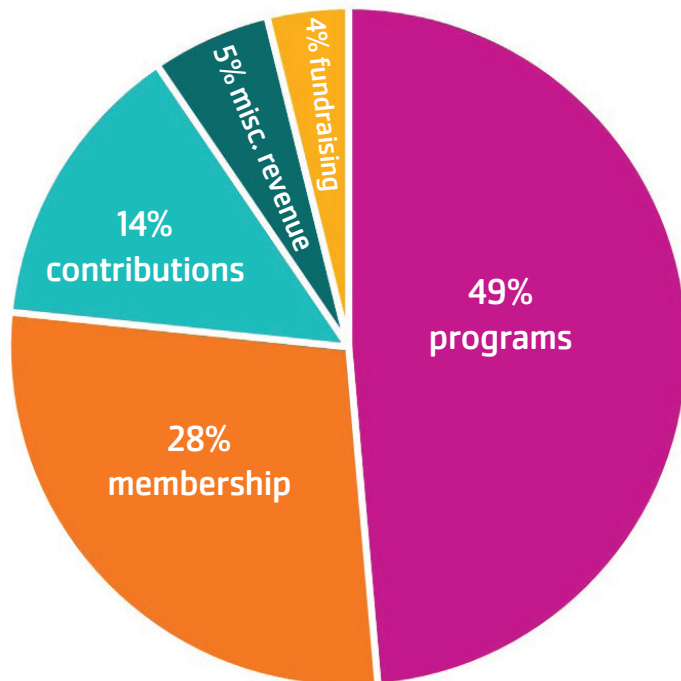

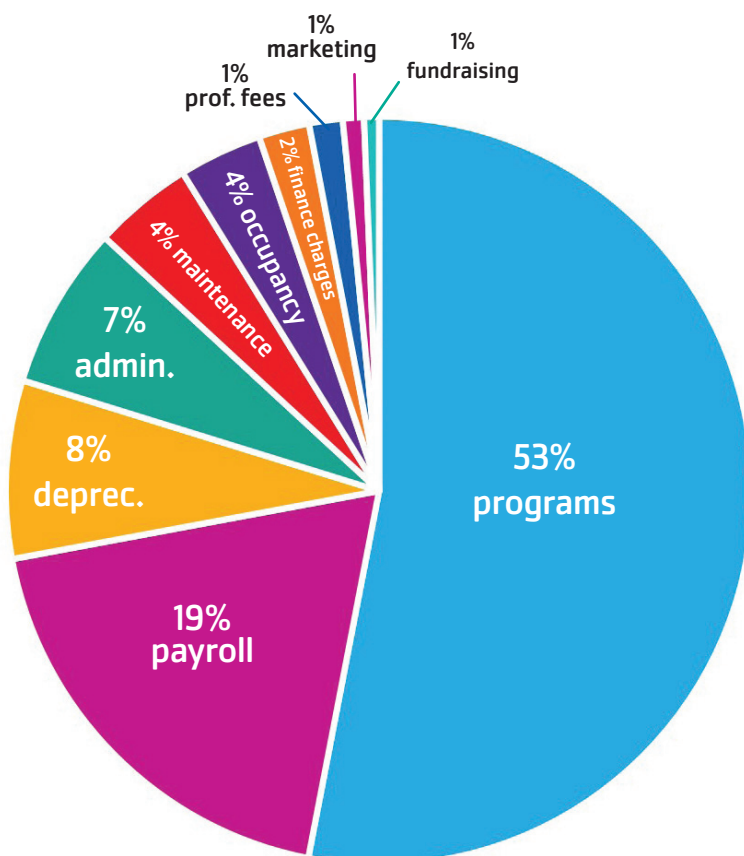

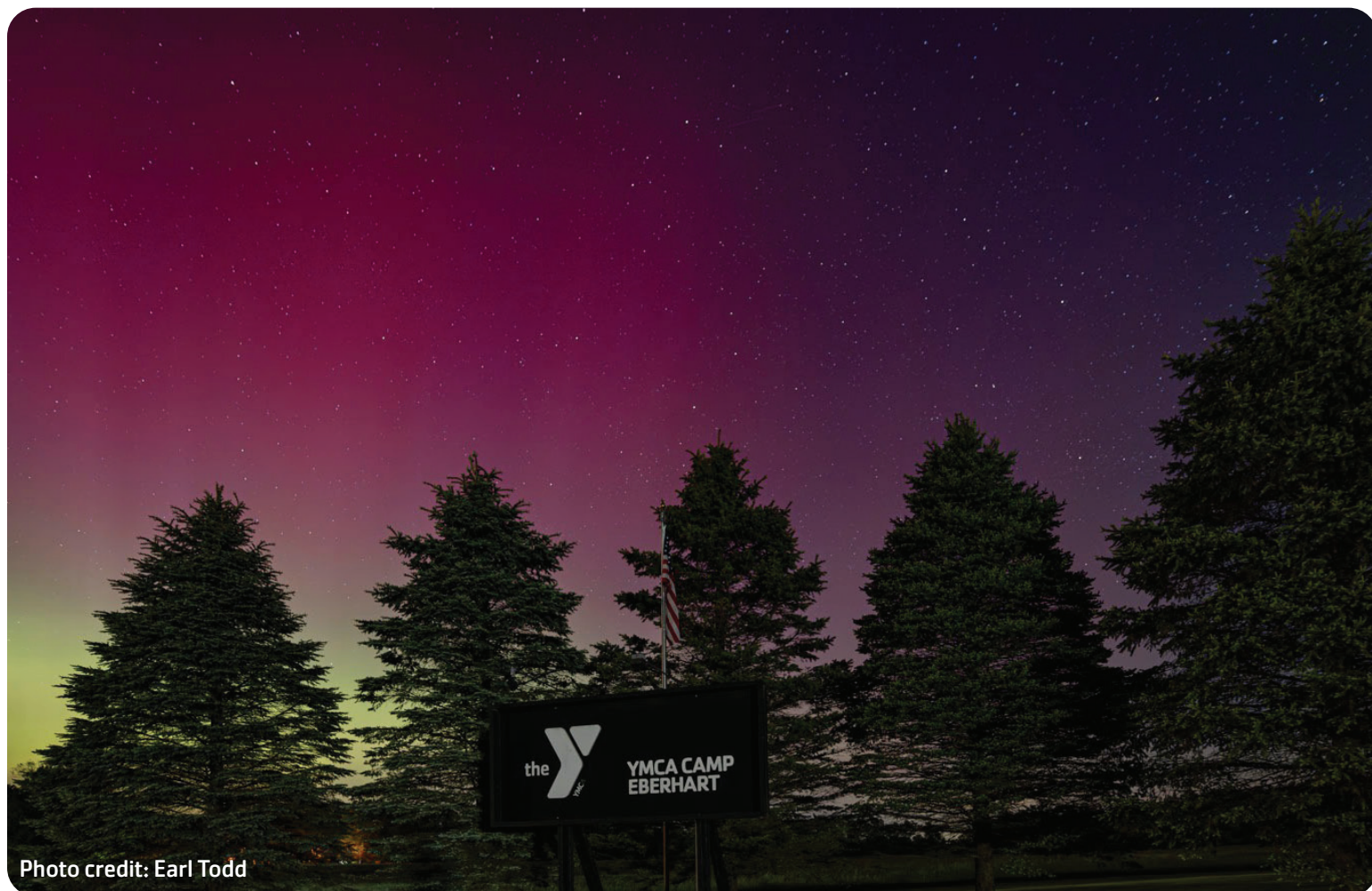
