PROGRAMS

All campers get to participate in programs during Summer Day Camp. Campers that are in Preschool through Kindergarten will get to sample each of our programs as they rotate through the week.

Campers that are First Grade and up will get to choose their programs at the beginning of the week. Our trained staff will lead campers through activities that are inspired by the themes of the week. Each day will be a new activity within that program.

Arts and Crafts | Campers will experience weekly themed activities to tap into their inner artist. Campers will have an opportunity to earn awards in beading, weaving, drawing, and painting.

Landsports | Campers will experience different sports to expand their knowledge on the game, increase their physical activity, and develop teamwork.

STEAM | Campers will participate in activities centered around Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics.

Drama | Campers will get to create, produce, and perform in their own productions. Learn to act, improve, and create sets and scripts. Camp Readers | Campers will explore learning through books. Not just reading different works, but completing literacy theme projects, while becoming authors and illustrators.

Archery | Campers will learn the fundamentals and safety of Archery.

Outdoor Ed. | Campers will learn about the outdoors, by gardening, plant identification, weather tracking, and survival.

Climbing | Campers will learn and expand their skills in Rockwall and Bouldering. They will practice routing paths and growing their climbing abilities, all while focused on safety and best practices. (Campers must be between 25–310 lbs to participate).

Registration & Payment Information

- A \$50 non-refundable deposit for each registered week must be paid to retain your child's place unless you pay in full at the time of sign-up. Deposit goes toward weekly fee. Deposits can not be transfered to other weeks.
- Final payment must be paid two Fridays prior to the start of care. If final payment is not made, the available spot will be filled by a child on the waitlist.
- Camp is a licensed child care program. Please fill out and return the necessary forms after completing online registration. All paperwork can be found here.
- Families will receive a "What to Expect" email before the start of each week.
- Any billing questions or changes, stop by Member Services or call the YMCA O'Brien Center at 574–299–3482.

Cancelation Policy

- A week notice is required to receive a full refund (excluding deposit).
- Less than a week's notice, 50% system credit will be issued (excluding deposit).
- Notices given on or after the first day of programming, no refund will be issued.
